
It has been another busy summer with time in the studio and preparing 12 of my watercolour images for publication in the 2017 calendar of the Portage Mutual Insurance Company. While many of the pieces featured in the calendar have already been sold, you can view them and other, unsold paintings on my website.



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The process of creating the familiar begins with my walking the land near my country home, south of Humboldt, SK. I continue to be transported by often contradictory images of our vanishing prairie, which evoke activity long past and yet momentarily remembered. The doubleness of that memory creates an often disconcerting instability, by both conveying and subverting a life that is past.

By detailing these everyday and familiar places and things, I implicitly challenge the ways that we forget, overlook and undervalue the past.

These rural businesses were the focal point of small communities where area people purchased fuel, machinery, and parts in addition to gathering information on local people and events in the surrounding region. \$720.00.

The local independent gas station with a garage was once an essential business for a town, connecting rural communities with the outside world. This station's classic western building design had an iconic simplicity, characteristic of many prairie town structures. These stations were functional buildings, built with close proximity to the pumps for customer service. The dual lights at the pumps remained lit throughout extended evening hours, as they did in the city.

I am delighted to share that 12 of my paintings have been chosen by Manitoba's Portage Mutual Insurance Company to be featured in their 2017 calendar. I have been working with Leech Printing (Brandon, MB) to prepare the images. The calendar will be distributed by

agents across Canada and copies will be available through me. If you email me your mailing address **before September 9, 2016**, I will be pleased to send you a copy, as a gift. But supplies are limited, so please act quickly!

Last winter, I was again honoured with the award for "Excellence in Watercolour," at the 2016 Mann Gallery Juried show in Prince Albert, SK.

Enclosed please find your own copy of Manitoba's Portage Mutual Insurance Company's 2017 calendar. Each month features reproductions of my original paintings. I hope you enjoy the images throughout the next year!

Between now and December 15, 2016 only, I am offering a 20% discount on current website prices. I'm doing so primar/ily to thank you for your long-term interest and simultaneously to reduce the size of my inventory. Prices will increase on most of the available pieces on the site, effective January 1, 2017.

When you make a purchase, I do not allow any art to leave my studio, unless it's professionally framed and prepared to be viewed. That way, the manner by which I view my subjects is transported directly to you. Due to the fragile nature of glass, I ship my work with an acrylic face, recommending that you replace it with glass, when you receive the art. There is a nominal handling charge (\$25 to cover packaging, etc.), to ensure that the painting reaches you soundly. And I will provide a shipping quote through Canada Post or a courier (if you prefer), prior to sale.
